

## CEED Service Development & Training Packages Options 2015

CEED is considering offering a service development and training strategy that attempts to assist scoping the needs and plan with services for eating disorders responses. This would involve offering the preparatory service meetings, an intensive (3 to 5 days) training package to a metro/regional service system, and the ongoing support to clinicians as new therapies and service systems are embedded. There is an expression of interest (EOI) process that enables CEED and the service region to develop a training package that strengthens and builds a multidisciplinary team for eating disorders. Below is a brief draft of the training package options and the possible and the timeline for development of a strategy and implementation.
